



## CODE OF CONDUCT

The organizations at White Sands Missile Range, NM, and Holloman Air Force Base are professional environments and enforce the following Code of Conduct:

- Dignity for the individual and respect for all personal rights and property
- An environment respectful of people from diverse backgrounds and belief systems
- Personal behavior that is minimally disruptive to the workplace and respectful of all laboratory occupants
- Careful handling of all laboratory equipment and materials
- Timeliness
- Cleanliness

The following types of misconduct will not be tolerated:

- Name-calling
- Theft
- Use of inappropriate or foul language (including language on garments)
- Purposeful damage to others' belongings and/or laboratory equipment and materials
- Bodily harm to a fellow student, GEMS staff member or White Sands Missile Range employee
- Any behavior considered improper for the laboratory and educational environment

These behaviors and other instances of misconduct will be independently evaluated by the GEMS program staff. Discipline will be carried out in a prompt but fair manner and may take the form of immediate contact with parents/guardians and/or dismissal from the program at any time during the week.
