WHAT IS THE MINI-GRANT?

The eCYBERMISSION Mini-Grant is intended to support teachers/program leaders as they implement eCYBERMISSION with their teams.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Educators (formal and informal) of students in grades 6-9. Special consideration is given to Title 1 schools and to those with underserved/under-represented populations.

GRANT STRUCTURE

The grant award is released in two payments. The initial payment (onethird of the total grant) is sent to the school/ district/organization to be used for supplies/ professional development to implement team projects. The second payment (remaining two-thirds of the award) is sent directly to the educator to be used at her/ his discretion in support of STEM.

NEXT STEPS

Mini-Grant awardees will be notified, on a rolling basis, until October 24, 2018. In order to secure funding, all Team Advisors and students must be registered for the competition/on complete teams by November 21, 2018. After eCYBERMISSION registration closes, the initial grant payment will be sent to the school/district/organization. Targeted first payment is by December 19, 2018.
